Again, thank you to all those who contributed.






























## Joe Suprano:


Brother Joseph Suprano assumed the responsibility of coordinating the Theta Chi Golf Outing held each year from Brother Boylan.

It was his efforts to continue the tradition until he turned the reins over to the Alumni Board after 2019 to keep brothers connected in a way that eventually helped provide the alumni support for the re-colonization of the chapter in 2017.

He also served on the alumni Board from 2017-2019.

Brother Suprano, after a recommendation from Brother Dan Angelucci, began "passing the can" at outings to collect funds to establish a Commemorative Brick Fund.

The purpose of the fund was to cover the cost of placing a brick (which costs \$100 each) on the Slippery Rock University Alumni House patio with the name and notation of being a Theta Chi recognizing that the Initiated Brother had passed on to the Chapter Eternal. Though at the time Theta Chi had no presence on campus, this display has become the largest display on the patio recognizing over 32 brothers at Slippery Rock University and is a display for which every Zeta Alpha member is proud.



The Board also submitted a request and was granted a Theta Chi Citation for Brother Doug Bull. Board Member Farrar presented the citation to Brother Bull at his home in Dallas. Pictured here from Left to Right are Brother Gary Perdue, Brother Doug Bull (displaying his citation) and Brother Gary Eckert.

The rational for his citation is printed below:

Douglas M. Bull served on the alumni Board from its creation in 2017 to 2021 and President of the Alumni Board from June 2018 until June 2021. He was instrumental in the creation of and approval of the Alumni Bylaws creating the Zeta Alpha Alumni Chapter of Theta Chi, Inc.

During his four year term on the Board and while serving as President, the chapter was rechartered in April of 2018, the Alumni Board created the Helping Hand Scholarship Fund and brought it to a \$25,000 endowment status to support Chapter Collegians in need, established separate accounting for the Memorial Brick fund to commemorate the passing of Zeta Alpha Chapter Brothers to the Chapter Eternal and began the process of involving more recent alumni in the Alumni Board creating a strong foundation for years to come.



## Sad News





After the collection of your data for Theta Chi, they will ask if you would like to participate in the project. There is no obligation to participate.




Some things to know.
