Results of the Election of Directors and Officers

I am pleased to present the results of the recent election to fill three (3) vacancies on the Board of Directors, effective June 1, 2026.

Earlier this year, advance notification of these vacancies was shared with the membership, inviting nominations in accordance with our Alumni Bylaws. Nominations closed on April 1, 2026. An official ballot, along with candidate profiles, was distributed electronically on April 10, 2026. Voting was open from April 10 through April 25, 2026, to eligible members of the Zeta Alpha Chapter of Theta Chi Fraternity — including alumni in good standing, honorary members voted in by the Chapter, and initiates of any Theta Chi collegiate chapter elected into the corporation by the Board of Directors.

Each voter was allowed to cast votes for up to three (3) candidates. The results were as follows:

- Brother Lucian Dean – (86.6% of ballots cast)
- Brother John Farrar – (80% of ballots cast)
- Brother Grant Riley – (86.6% of ballots cast)

A total of 82 ballots were submitted.

As a result, Brothers Lucian Dean, John Farrar and Grant Riley have been elected to serve as Directors for the term of June 1, 2026, through May 31, 2028. Congratulations to these outstanding brothers on their election!

Following the conclusion of the Director election, a meeting has been scheduled for May 3, 2026 to finalize plans for the Weekend Golf Outing and the incoming Board members to elect officers whose term will begin June 1, 2026.

We also take this opportunity to recognize and sincerely thank Brothers Cooper Collins and Andrew Auth for their dedicated service to the Board. Their contributions have been invaluable, and they leave a legacy of commitment and leadership.

Please join me in congratulating our newly elected Directors and Officers and in expressing gratitude to our retiring Board members for their outstanding service.

We hope to be able to sign a contract and pay a deposit for 2027 before we leave the property this year.

This year we have made strides in codifying Board policies and combine them in one place where again we try to make sure all available information is **available to all**. The Board met on June 29, 2026, February 1, 2026 and March 29, 2026 and plans its final meeting of the year on May 3 to finalize plans for the outing and to elect officers for the 2026-2027 year.

For those of you who have been with us since the first recolonization newsletter in October of 2016.

The chapter has come a long way since recolonizing on September 30, 2017 now with over 50 members. Their efforts earned them a:

- Howard R. Alter Jr. Award for excellence being only 1 of 9 chapters recognized out of over 160 chapters.
- Henry B. Hersey Significant Increase in Membership Award Honorable mention.
- Phil S. Randall Success in Recruitment Award.

This has been due to the efforts of the members and leadership of the Chapter and contribution of time, talent and treasure by Alumni. Those contributions are invaluable to help the chapter to continue to achieve.

Treasurer Report

The Alumni Association has continued to work hard to keep record keeping both accurate and transparent to all members of both the Undergraduate Chapter and Alumni Brothers of Zeta Alpha. Our three major undertakings each year that require funding are the Annual Golf Outing, Homecoming at Slippery Rock and Memorial Bricks for Brothers who have transitioned to the Chapter Eternal.

Memorial Brick Fund

The Memorial Brick Fund started by Brother Suprano by passing the coffee can at the golf outing has not required any additional fundraising over the past several years.

The Memorial Brick Fund is kept in a savings account and when memorial bricks are needed the funds are transferred to the General Fund and the purchase is made.

We authorized additional memorial bricks which will result in the purchases of 4 bricks this past calendar year. Each year in June, the Secretary completes the order for all needed bricks forwarding the orders and expenditures to pay for the bricks to be placed at Slippery Rock Alumni House Patio.

This year we also placed a notification form in the Chapter Eternal section of the website so the Board can be informed of the passing of a brother and arrangements for a memorial Brick can be made.

It was learned that recently bricks were purchased outside the process, that has been shared for years with the Alumni. Aldom – 240-321, David Grabosky 240-360 and Theodore Disalvo - 240-364 were ordered to be placed. Not all are in the normal format of all others that have been placed. This causes confusion a lack of consistency in the display and extra work for no reason. A duplicate will not be ordered and whomever did this will not be compensated.

General Fund

The General Fund is used to fund the annual events of the Alumni Association and more importantly to support the chapter.

As stated earlier, the Golf outing and Homecoming, and some administrative costs associated with maintaining the website are the ongoing yearly expenses. There may be other specific expenses that arise from the Undergraduate Chapter or the Alumni Chapter which the BOD may approve as expenditures on an as needed basis.

The Chapter has shown respect for the process and did not need to use funds allocated for the Initiative Academy attendance in July 2025 and did not spend the entire allocation of funds for Homecoming. In all cases, receipts are required before expenses are reimbursed.

Helping Hand Scholarship Fund

Now that the Theta Chi Helping Hand Fund is an Endowment, the Slippery Rock Foundation prepares a yearly scholarship report for the Alumni Board. The Foundation's fiscal accounting runs from July 1- June 30 of the following year. So we have to an Endowment Account that no money is allocated for use and an Interest Account (not just interest but any funds collected above the Endowment total.) Any scholarships awarded or donations received are all deposited or withdrawn from the Interest Account.

The Undergraduate Chapter is allotted \$1,000.00 each year 1/1 thru 12/31 to award scholarships. The scholarships can be in any amount from \$5.00 to \$500 per student per calendar year. If the chapter does not award all the available scholarship funds during the year the money allocated can roll over to the next calendar year. As of this annual report the available balance for use by the Chapter is \$4,000.00.

An audit was completed with the SRU Foundation on the account and adjusted balances appear below:

This annual report highlights the achievements of our chapter this academic year. Despite our locations, we're bound together by Theta Chi's ideals, memories, and dedication to our forever brotherhood.

As Chapter Advisor, I'm pleased to share remarkable accomplishments of the chapter including:

- The Chapter's Executive Board met over the summer to keep it's momentum.
- We would also like to recognize those 14 brothers with a 3.0 – 3.49 GPA for the Fall Semester: Ian Campbell, Giovanni Clark, Rob Grasinger, Joe Hemple, Austin Henne, Ron Howard, Matt Hurst, Aidan Keller, Jake Levy, KJ Meek, Dylan Rider, Aidan Smith, Connor Solomon, Vincent Tavorario.

The average GPA for the Zeta Alpha Chapter for the Fall of 2025 – 3.084

The all men's student GPA average for Fall 2025 – 3.17

The all fraternity student GPA average for Fall 2025 – 3.086
The all women's student GPA average for Fall 2025 – 3.43
All sorority student GPA average for Fall 2025 – 3.482
All undergraduate average – 3.31

- **Recognition** - At the Initiative Academy at Indiana University, in July, the chapter was awarded the Howard R. Alter Jr. Award for Excellence being only 1 of 9 chapters recognized out of over 160 chapters, Henry B. Hersey Significant Increase in Membership Award Honorable Mention and the Phil S. Randall Success in Recruitment Award.

The chapter has been recognized by the Slippery Rock University Student Engagement and Leadership earning the **Excellence in Membership Development Award**. See a picture of the award at https://zachapter.com/?page_id=5723 (The most recent information is at bottom of the page.)

- Finances are always a struggle for any chapter. The Executive Board is working to help brothers understand when financial commitments are due and the amounts so they may be able to deal with the financial deadlines. For the 2025-2026 academic year dues for each semester are \$281 plus \$18 for Greek Bill (the software for chapters to manage their finances, specifically for tasks like billing members, collecting payments, and tracking expenses.) It provides tools for treasurers to streamline these processes, moving away from manual methods.

Additionally, the Chapter members usually equally divide (once a year) the cost of Chapter Spot (a CRM or Customer Relationship Management software) fee of \$360 for administrative access to Theta Chi International's membership management. So, in 2026-2027 in the fall and spring each member/pledge will pay \$289. Each year dues can increase by as much as (2% - 6% a year.) a pledge fee of \$339 is in addition to dues.

The Executive Board of the Chapter continues to work on the WHY as to what they are paying and the benefits it purchases. It is clear the commitment the current collegians have made to be a member of the Zeta Alpha Chapter of Theta Chi Fraternity is obvious and some may say appropriate for the time. But from what we can see, it is the value the members perceive from those fees.

- The Chapter finished 2025 strongly with the election of its 2026 Officers. Several brothers competed for the positions, to which they were elected, demonstrating the enthusiasm to continue their success. A list of officers can be found on the website at https://zachapter.com/?page_id=1377.
- Chapter President Jake Levy is not only serving as Chapter President but also IFC President and currently holds one of only 8 seats on the Theta Chi Fraternity Chapter Presidents Advisory Council. In addition to providing leadership and insight, Brother Jake will be on the convention election committee assisting in the Grand Chapter elections!
- Brothers Jake Levy and Caleb Hankee will be representing the chapter along with Alumni President Krepinevich at the 170th Anniversary Celebration of Theta Chi Fraternity and the 42nd school of fraternity practices to be held July 10-14, 2026 in San Antonio, TX.
- **Resolute Man** - Brothers Cole Clary, Nate Waugaman, Kaan Ozdemir, Keaton (KJ) Meek, Jake Levy, Matthew Rybolt and Blake Naeger earned their Resolute Man designation with 15 Zeta Alpha brothers having achieved this recognition. - **Training** - The Chapter President, Vice President, Health and Safety Vice President, Recruitment Chair and Marshal attended the January Officers Training Conference held in Indianapolis, IN, January 9-11, 2026, obtaining insight into their

- responsibilities, sharing information and networking with fellow brothers from all over the country bringing back ideas to the chapter.
- The Spring semester was slow in starting due to Slippery Rock University being closed for a couple days because of the snowstorm!
 - The chapter is expecting a large group of Seniors preparing to graduate (approximately 10) which has naturally led to a bit of the “usual” senior disengagement. That said, the chapter remains tied as the largest organization on campus and continues to have a strong presence. The chapter has participated in a variety of activities supporting the brothers, the campus and the community which are too many to list here but can be found by visiting the most recent activities of the chapter on the website at https://zachapter.com/?page_id=3988 (2025) https://zachapter.com/?page_id=5723. (2026 so far.)
 - Recruitment resulted with 16 new brothers for the year (2025-2026) successfully completing the Resolute Journey and being initiated.
 - The Chapter held a Founders Day Event on April 12 at 11:00 a.m. including a cookout, yard games and a variety of other activities. The chapter enthusiastically inviting alumni brothers to attend.
 - Chapter President Jake Levy distributed an email/newsletter to the alumni on March 22, 2026 highlighting items so far this year. He also reported that the chapter’s retention rate is excellent and efforts are being made to place an emphasis on involvement and communication to maintain the membership.
 - The chapter members continue to express enthusiasm for the promotion of and participation in the Golf Outing Weekend.
 - Though the Spring semester is set to close on May 9th with the completion of finals and graduation.

Working with the SRU Alumni Association, they have informed us that the SRU Alumni Weekend is the same weekend and there are rooms on campus available for \$74 - \$90 a night per person. If you ARE a Marriott Bonvoy member the cost of the room for 2 nights is \$441.78 (including tax.)

Call the hotel and explain you are part of the Theta Chi Fraternity Alumni Board Group and you wish to reserve one of the rooms held by the block. At that time, the hotel will request a credit card to hold the room and an email address to confirm your reservation for your records.

Rooms will be sold on a first-come-first served basis and when gone they are gone.
